

Third Convocation Ceremony, RTU, KOTA

FAQ

- Date of convocation is 3rd March 2012.
 - To award degrees to 2010 and 2011 (B.Tech, MBA, MCA, B.Arch, M.Tech and BHMCT) passed out students.
- Only pass out students with the following criteria can attend
 - The candidate must have passed the examinations in First Division and in the first attempt.
 - B.Tech: Top 2 candidates from each branch of 2010 & 2011 passed out batch
 - B.Arch: Top 2 candidates from each branch of 2011 passed out batch
 - MBA: Top 5 candidates from each branch of 2010 & 2011 passed out batch
 - MCA: Top 2 candidates from each branch of 2010 & 2011 passed out batch
 - M.Tech: Topper of each program (with available results) from 2010 & 2011 passed out batch
 - BHMCT: Top 2 candidates from each branch of 2010 & 2011 passed out batch
 - Eligible Students can attend the convocation ceremony by invitation only. (Not open to all the students)
 - Only the students whose names appear in the list for Convocation, need to send consent form and the DD, other students need not send anything to the University. Students other than the list are not allowed to attend the convocation program. Their degree will be directly sent to their respective colleges.
- How to register
 - The students having their names in the list for Convocation need to send consent form along with a Bank DD of Rs. 500/- in favor of "Registrar, Rajasthan Technical University", payable at Kota.
 - Consent form to be sent to Convener (Convocation-2012), Director Academics Office, Rajasthan Technical University, Rawatbhata Road, Kota-324010.
 - Last Date for receiving the consent form is 25th Feb. 2012. Eligible candidates, willing to attend Convocation must send their consent such that it reaches us before the last date. No request will be entertained after that.
 - Format of consent form and lists of eligible students are available on the RTU website.
- When and where to Report
 - Students who have submitted the consent form by the due date need to report to Rajasthan Technical University, Kota campus on 2nd March 2012, 10A.M.
 - Students who fail to attend *full-dress-rehearsal* on 2nd March 2012 will not be permitted to attend the convocation ceremony on 3rd March 2012.

- A student is allowed to bring one person (only) along with him/her (family member) to accompany him/her in the convocation ceremony.
- The eligible students may please take care of the dress code (mentioned in the consent form), failing which they may not be allowed to attend convocation.

➤ Accommodation

- Accommodation to girl candidates coming alone to Kota is available on payment basis in the campus. Rest all the candidates and their companions should make their own stay arrangements. We regret for the inconvenience.
- Girls coming alone may mention their request for accommodation in the consent form. Depending upon the availability, they will be provided accommodation.
