## Notification

As per the recommendation of the Faculty of Management and approved by Academic council, the following shall be the additional provision in promotion scheme for MBA and BHMCT.

### Additional provisions in promotion scheme of MBA.

- 8.6 If a candidate fails in internal exam, He/She shall appear in the internal back exam, marks secured in term end theory of that subject shall be carried forward.
- 8.7 A candidate shall be eligible to appear in the next higher semester exam irrespective of the number of papers cleared in the previous semester. However, the candidate will have to clear the remaining uncleared papers by appearing in back examinations of the respective semester (Maximum duration 4 years) that means a candidate shall get maximum 3 chances (1 main exam + 2 back exams) to pass any theory exam. This provision shall be applicable from academic session 2008-09 till further review.
- 8.8 If a candidate fails to secure 50% semester aggregate marks but has cleared all the papers. He/She may be eligible to improve maximum two theory papers (excluding internal exam) in which marks obtained are less than 50%. However, in semester aggregate only 50% marks shall be considered irrespective of the marks secured after improvement.

### Additional provisions in promotion scheme of BHMCT.

- 8.9 If a candidate fails in internal exam, He/She shall appear in the internal back exam, marks secured in term end theory of that subject shall be carried forward.
- 9.3 A candidate shall be eligible to appear in II, III, and IV semester examinations without any check point. However, promotion to next higher semester shall be as mentioned in the table given below:-

The examination required to be passed- before appearing exams (1)	Examination in which student (2)
No check point	I,II,III & IV Semester
I Sem should be clear	V Sem.
II Sem should be clear	VI Sem.
III Sem should be clear	VII Sem.
IV Sem should be clear	VIII Sem.

A candidate shall get maximum 4 chances (1 main exam + 3 back exams) to pass any theory exam.

- 9.4 If a candidate fails to secure 50% (aggregate of the academic year) marks but has cleared all the papers. He/She may be eligible to improve maximum two theory papers (excluding internal exam) in which marks obtained are less than 50%. However, in semester aggregate only 50% marks shall be considered irrespective of the marks secured after improvement.
