**INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE GUIDANCE OF CANDIDATES APPEARING IN
RAJASTHAN PRE ENGINEERING TEST (RPET-2008) FOR ADMISSION TO FIRST
YEAR OF B.Tech./B.E./B.Arch. COURSES FOR THE SESSION 2008-2009**

It contains Instructions, Syllabus, Sample Questions and Sample Answer Sheet etc., for the guidance of the candidates about RAJASTHAN PRE ENGINEERING TEST (RPET)-2008. The candidate should read the booklet carefully and note the contents of the Syllabus and Examination Scheme etc. carefully and prepare for RPET-2008 accordingly.

1. WHO CAN APPLY FOR RPET-2008

Candidates seeking admission to I Year B.Tech./B.E. in Engineering Colleges in Rajasthan on the basis of merit in RPET-2008. 15% seats are reserved in each college for payment seats in each branch, for those candidates who have qualified AIEEE-2008 and are not bonafide residents of Rajasthan.

However, Candidates seeking admission to I year of **B.Arch.** shall appear in NATA (National Aptitude Test in Architecture conducted by Council of Architecture) instead of appearing for RPET 2008. They need not apply for RPET-2008 examination. However, at the time of counselling, they shall apply to RPET admission committee along with fee, NATA score card and marks in qualifying examination (pl. See 3.1D). Separate advertisement in this regard will be issued at the time of counselling.

2. RPET FORM

(a) Application Form - The RPET-2008 Application Form was published in the State News Papers on 5th/ 6th April 2008. The candidates can get the same zeroxed in two A-4 size copies. The Application Form can also be downloaded in two copies from the website www.rtu.ac.in/rpet-2008

(b) An Application Form together with attached documents makes one set. Candidates are required to send two such sets. A complete Application Form consists of:

(i) Two sets of Application Forms (with attached documents)

(j) Demand Draft of Rs. 900/- (Rs. Nine hundred only) in favour of **Coordinator, RPET-2008 payable at Kota.**

(k) Candidates should write their names, address and choice of centre at the back of DD.

(l) Self-Addressed envelopes (properly stamped).

(c) How to Send Application Form - Duly filled in Application Form (in two sets with attached documents) along with DD and self-addressed envelopes should reach Coordinator, RPET-2008, Rajasthan Technical University, Akelgarh, Rawatbhata Road, KOTA-324022 latest by 25th April, 2008 up to 5.00 p.m. by Speed post/ Registered post/ in person only (not by courier in any case).

Notes: (1) The fee deposited for RPET-2008 is neither refundable nor transferable for future RPET.

(2) A plea that the candidate failed to receive the information for appearing at the RPET-2008 or not permitted to appear at the RPET-2008 or otherwise will not be accepted as a ground for the refund of fee or any other dues.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

A candidate must ensure that he / she is eligible for admission to various Governments and private technical institutions of Rajasthan (except BITS Pilani, MNIT Jaipur and other Deemed Universities) before filling up the RPET-2008 form. **If a non-eligible candidate is admitted due to any reason then the admission of such a candidate will be cancelled as soon as the mistake is detected even at later stage.** Various eligibility criteria shall be as under:

3.1 EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

A. The minimum academic qualification for admission to B.Tech./B.E./B.Arch. program in Rajasthan is a pass in the final examination of 10+2 (Class XII) of Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan or any other examination recognized equivalent thereto by Universities in Rajasthan.

B. Subject combination required in the qualifying examination for admission to B.Tech./B.E. courses shall be as under:

Course	Compulsory Subjects	Any one of the Optional Subjects
B.Tech./B.E.	Physics & Mathematics	(1) Chemistry (2) Bio-technology (3) Computer Science (4) Biology

C. Candidates who are appearing in the qualifying examination class XII (Main), 2008 will be provisionally permitted to appear in RPET-2008. Such candidates will be eligible for subsequent counselling and admission, provided they pass in the class XII (Main) Examination and also in all the three subjects as above. However, all such candidates shall produce proof of having passed the qualifying examination latest by **10th June, 2008**.

D. **For Architecture Course: For admission to B.Arch. course** a candidate must appear in NATA (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) in 2008 conducted by the Council of Architecture(COA). However, their merit shall be decided by admission committee of RPET–2008 based on the ranking of NATA and marks in the qualifying examination. A candidate should have any one of the following qualifications:

Eligibility: (As per Council of Architecture)

(a) 10+2 or equivalent examination from a recognized Board with Mathematics as a subject of study by securing 50% marks in aggregate.

OR

(b) 10+3 diploma (any stream) recognized by Central/State Govt. with 50% aggregate marks.

OR

(c) International Baccalaureate Diploma, after 10 years of schooling not less than 50% marks in aggregate and with Mathematics as compulsory subject of examination.

For SC, ST & OBC candidates the aggregate is 45% marks in the above said examination.

Besides this, other benefits as provided by the Govt. of India and respective State Govt. to the SC, ST, OBC, Women, Economically backward, Ex-Serviceman, Physically handicapped students as applicable to them for pursuing the B.Arch. degree course are also to be extended.

All admissions to B.Arch. degree courses shall be subject to passing of National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) conducted by Council of Architecture (COA). The minimum pass score for NATA is 80 out of 200 for all categories of candidates. There is no relaxation in the minimum pass score of NATA to any category of candidate.

Process of Admission to Architecture Courses:

(1) Candidate shall appear for National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) conducted by the Council of Architecture. Test Centre for NATA in Rajasthan is “Aayojan School of Architecture, Jaipur”. Other test centres in other states are available on website of NATA (www.nata.in).

NATA is conducted ONLINE and the facility can be availed with prior appointment at the Test Centre. For further details candidates may see the website: www.nata.in

However, all such candidates shall produce proof of having passed the qualifying examination latest by **10th June, 2008**.

(2) Merit Criteria -

50% of NATA score

50% of Qualifying Examination (As per Council of Architecture)

The fee to be paid for counselling of Architecture shall be as decided by the admission committee of RPET-2008 which will be notified later.

3.2 AGE

A candidate desirous to take admission through RPET-2008, should be less than 23 years of age as on 1st October, 2008 i.e. he / she must have been born on or after 2nd October 1985 (Upper age limit is relaxable up to 3 years in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST). **Minimum age limit has been waived off from this year. Date of birth as recorded in the secondary education mark sheet/certificate will be taken as authentic.**

3.3 MEDICAL FITNESS:

A candidate desirous of admission to Engineering/Architecture Colleges will have to deposit the Medical Fitness Certificate at the time of reporting in the allotted institution on the prescribed form certified by a Medical Officer of the Government of Rajasthan as per medical standards laid down below:

Height: Not less than 1.5 m for male candidates and not less than 1.4 m for female candidates.

Weight: Not less than 41 kg. for male candidates and 37 kg for female candidates (Approximately).

Chest Measurement: Not less than 69 cm with satisfactory limits of expansion and contraction (for male candidates only).

Heart & Lungs: No abnormality.

Hernia, Hydrocele, Piles etc.: Presence of any of these will be a temporary disqualification to be rectified before joining the courses of study.

Vision: Normal. Where defective, it must be corrected to 6/9 in the better eye and 6/12 in the worse eye. Eyes should be free from congenital and other diseases. In case of admission to Mining Engineering courses, the candidates must be free from colour blindness (inability to distinguish between principal colours) also.

Hearing: Normal. Where defective, it must be corrected.

Speech: Normal.

The doctor will also have to certify that the candidate is medically fit for Engineering/Architecture profession.

3.4 DOMICILE CRITERIA

Candidate seeking admission to Engineering/Architecture Colleges in Rajasthan should note that he / she would be eligible for admission only if he / she fulfils any of the following conditions:

A. The candidate himself / herself **or** any of his / her natural parents (father / mother) is a bonafide resident of Rajasthan.

OR

B. Candidate has studied continuously as a regular student in recognized educational institutions in Rajasthan for the preceding three years up to and including the year in which he/she has passed / appearing the qualifying examination (i.e. X, XI and XII classes).

OR

C. Candidate is a son/daughter of either a serving employee or of a retired employee of any of the following:

(i) Government of Rajasthan (including officers of All India Service borne on the State cadre of Rajasthan).

(ii) Undertakings/ Corporations/ Improvement Trusts/ Municipal Boards/Panchayat Samities / Co-operative Bodies duly constituted by the Government of Rajasthan.

(iii) Statutory Bodies and Corporations formed under the Indian Companies Act incorporated in Rajasthan.

OR

D. Candidate is a son/daughter of an employee of any of the Universities in Rajasthan or Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan or Government Engineering Colleges at Bhilwara, Kota, Ajmer and Bikaner, who has put in at least three years service on the date of submission of application in any of the above bodies.

OR

E. Candidate is a son/daughter of an employee of Central Government or Institutions of the Central Government including Public Sector Undertakings or Corporations and who is on the regular rolls and is serving in the State of Rajasthan on the date of application.

OR

F. Candidate is a son/daughter of an employee of Rajasthan origin, serving in Defence/Central Government services/Public Sector undertakings/National Institutes of Government of India, who has put in at least three years service on the last date for submission of application irrespective of his/her place of posting provided a certificate is submitted by the

employee from the employer to this effect stating the State of origin and the home town as given by him/her at the time of his/her entry into service.

Note:

1. Ex-Servicemen (Ex-S) (Certificate No.3) and the Defence Killed (DK) (Certificate No. 4) persons should be of Rajasthan origin for eligibility of their children in these categories under 3.4. The State of origin and home town as entered in the discharge certificate shall only be accepted as proof in respect of the above. A copy of discharge certificate and PPO must necessarily be enclosed to seek reservation/ relaxation in the category. **The discharge certificate and PPO must be produced in original at the time of Reporting to Institutes.**
2. Sons/daughters of the displaced persons from Jammu & Kashmir (KM) shall be eligible for admission to Engineering/Architecture Colleges through RPET-2008. The candidate has to submit a certificate from the competent authority as a proof of being son/daughter of a displaced person from Jammu & Kashmir.

4. SUBMISSION OF RPET - 2008 APPLICATION FORM

The complete RPET-2008 form duly filled in candidate's own handwriting along with the enclosures should be put into A-4 size envelope and sent to **Coordinator, RPET-2008, Rajasthan Technical University, Akelgarh, Rawatbhata Road, KOTA-324022**. For submitting the Application Form any of the following options may be adopted:

- i. Send by Registered post / Speed post (**not by courier in any case**) so as to reach the **Coordinator, RPET-2008, Rajasthan Technical University, Akelgarh, Rawatbhata Road, KOTA-324 022** latest by **25.4.2008 up to 5.00 P.M.**
- ii. Drop in the locked box kept outside RPET office during 10am to 5pm on all working days, **Rajasthan Technical University, KOTA** on or before **25.4.2008 up to 5 p.m.**
- iii. *In any case, the Application Form should not be handed over to any person.*

5. ENCLOSURES TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH RPET-2008 FORM:

1. **D.D. of Rs. 900/- in favour of "Coordinator, RPET-2008", payable at Kota.**
2. **An attested copy of Certificate / Mark sheet of High School / Secondary School (Class X) containing Date of Birth of the candidate.**
3. **An attested copy of Marks-sheet of XII Examination, as a proof of having passed the qualifying examination. In case of result of XII is awaited, zerox copy of admission card of appeared XII Exam.-2008 is to be enclosed and the mark sheet of XII shall be submitted latest by 10.6.2008.**
4. **Attested copy of the relevant domicile certificate whichever is applicable (Refer Para No. 3.4 and Certificate No. 1(i) to 1(vi))**
5. **Attested copy of relevant document necessary for claiming reservation in**
 - a. **Category-I: SC/ ST/ OBC (Refer Para No. 13& 14 and Certificate No. 2)**
 - b. **Category-II:PH/DK/Ex-S/KM (Refer Para No. 3.4, 13 & 14 and Certificate**

Also ensure that

- You have gone through the eligibility criteria
- You have enclosed a D.D. for Rs. 900/- & Write your Name, Address and Choice of Town for Test on backside of D.D.
- You have pasted 4 passport size photographs on two sets of Application Form.
- You have signed at the specified locations.
- You have enclosed the relevant documents as mentioned in the above box.
- You have kept a Photo Copy of filled in Application Form & DD with you for future reference.
- Ensure you have kept three self addressed envelopes inside:
 - i. One A4 size envelope with Rs. 30 stamps affixed.
 - ii. Two 6"x10" size envelopes with Rs. 5 stamps affixed.

6. IN CASE OF DEFECIENCY IN APPLICATION FORM

- In case the Application Form received from the candidate is found to be incomplete in any respect, the candidate would be conveyed to complete the same.
- This information of deficiencies will also be displayed on the website. Candidates are advised to see the web site regularly in order to avoid difficulty that may arise due to postal delay.
- In all such cases of deficiency, candidate will submit requisite documents along with a fee in the form of a D.D. of **Rs. 100/-** (Rs. One hundred only) in favour of “**Coordinator RPET-2008**” payable at **Kota**
- If a Candidate himself / herself wants to make certain change(s) in the filled in Application Form, he/she can do so on a fee in the form of a D.D. of **Rs. 100/-** (Rs. One hundred only) in favour of “**Coordinator RPET-2008**” payable at **Kota**, but such a request would be allowed till **5.5.2008** only.

7. ADMISSION CARD FOR RPET-2008

Admission Card for RPET-2008 will be sent to the candidate through the self addressed envelope. The Coordinator RPET-2008 may withdraw the permission granted by mistake to a candidate who is not eligible to appear at the RPET-2008 even though the Admission Card has been issued and produced by the candidate before the Centre Superintendent of RPET-2008.

In case the admission card is not received by the candidate **till 12.5.2008**, the candidate should contact the coordinator RPET-2008 immediately.

Such Candidates are advised to bring two passport size photographs (same as pasted on application form) at the time of examination.

8. EXAMINATION SCHEME

RPET-2008 shall consist of single examination of three hours duration containing 40 objective type questions in each of the subjects of Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics. The total no. of questions will be 120 carrying one mark each. **There is no negative marking for wrong answer.** The questions in the test booklet will be in Hindi as well as in English. However, in case of any difference in Hindi & English versions of question, **the questions in English shall be treated as valid.**

9. SCHEDULE OF EXAMINATION

RPET-2008 will be conducted on 22nd May, 2008 from 09 a.m. to 12 Noon.

10. Permission to appear in RPET-2008 shall not guarantee for fulfilling eligibility criteria for admission and only the eligible candidates as per RPET-2008 rules will be considered for counselling and subsequent admission.

11. UNFAIR MEANS

Warning: The candidates are warned that with the promulgation of Rajasthan Public Examination (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act, 1992 by the Government of Rajasthan vide Extraordinary Gazette Notification dated 11th November 1992, use of unfair means at a public examination is an offence under the law and accordingly the person(s) found guilty of resorting to or using unfair means at the RPET-2008 can be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend up to 3 years or with fine which may extend up to Rupees Two thousand or with both.

11.1. The following acts shall be considered as unfair means:

- i Tearing off the Test Booklet or any part thereof including answer sheet.
- ii Any attempt by candidate to obtain any information about question(s) set in examination paper or communication with any candidate in the examination hall.
- iii Communication by the candidate with any person concerned with the examination work with the intention of influencing him/her for the award of marks.
- iv Communication by the candidate with any person with the intention of obtaining information about the marks secured before declaration of the result of RPET-2008.
- v Any activity by the candidate, which in the opinion of the Invigilator is likely to give unfair advantage to him/her.
- vi Refusal/Resistance by the candidate for search to find out whether he/she possesses any objectionable material.
- vii Taking away the Test Booklet and/or Main Copy and first carbon copy of the answer sheet outside the examination hall.

11.2 If a complaint is lodged against a candidate that he/she used or attempted to use unfair means in the examination, the matter shall be placed before the Unfair Means Committee to be appointed by the Chairperson, RPET-2008 for recommendation and accordingly matter will be decided.

12. RE-EVALUATION / RE-TOTALLING

The candidates will have to make request on plain paper giving details like Roll No, Name, Paper, Centre etc. to the Coordinator RPET-2008 within 07 days (Seven days) of the display of ANSWER KEYS of RPET-2008 (on RPET Notice Board) and on payment of Rs. 100/- per subject by Bank Draft in favour of the Coordinator RPET-2008 payable at Kota.

- The answer sheets of the test shall not be subject to production before any Court (Civil or Criminal) or before the candidate or any body else on his / her behalf or before any internal or external authority.
- The answer sheets of candidates shall be preserved only for 3 months from the date of publication of the RPET-2008 merit list.

13. RESERVATION CATEGORIES

Acronyms of various categories are as follow:

Category –I	Category-II
GEN – General	Ex-S – Ex Serviceman
SC – Scheduled Caste	DK – Defence Killed
ST – Scheduled Tribe	PH – Physically Handicapped
OBC – Other Backward Classes	KM – Kashmiri Migrants

Definition of OBC Category: The benefit of reservation under OBC category shall be available only to the candidates of the castes listed either in the lists notified by the Govt. of Rajasthan or Govt. of India. Castes listed in the state lists of other than Rajasthan shall not be considered under this category.

14. NUMBER OF SEATS AND RESERVATION

- 14.1. Exact number of seats and branches will be notified through web site before counselling.
- 14.2. Except in case of unaided Private Institutions and 50% seats in the self-finance courses of the aided institutions, the reservation of seats will be made subject to the prevalent statutory provisions i.e. as per relevant rules and regulations of Govt. of Rajasthan viz. **16% for SC candidates, 12% for ST candidates and 21% for candidates belonging to OBC category.**
- 14.3. Horizontal reservation of 3% for candidates belonging to **Physically Handicapped**, 25% for women category and 3% for dependents of Defence Killed / Ex-Servicemen will also be made. Reservation Policy can be changed as per Govt. instructions (See annexure 1).

- 14.4. Up to 5% reservation of over & above the sanctioned strength to **Kashmiri Migrants** will be allowed as per norms. The candidate is required to submit a certificate from the competent authority as a proof of being son/daughter of a displaced person from Jammu & Kashmir.
- 14.5. Depending upon the option given by the institute(s) under **Tuition Fee waiver Scheme** up to 10% of sanctioned strength seats are allotted for meritorious- PH, Women & Economically Weaker Students as per AICTE guidelines (See guidelines no. 37-03/(Legal)/2007 dated 09.04.2007).

15. FEE STRUCTURE

Pursuant to the judgment dated 14-8-2003 of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case titled Islamic Academy of Education V/s State of Karnataka, the State Government has constituted a State Level Fee Committee for determination of fee structure for various technical courses including Engineering/Architecture courses.

As per the directions of the State Level Fees Committee the interim fee structure for Engineering/Architecture courses for the session- 2007-2008 was as under:

(a)	Aided Seats in Government Engineering Colleges.	18,000/- per annum + Rs. 2000/- caution money. (Refundable)
(b)	Self Finance seats in Government Engineering Colleges.	42,000/- per annum + Rs. 2000/- caution money. (Refundable)
(c)	Private Engineering/Architecture Colleges.	42,000/- per annum + Rs. 2000/- caution money. (Refundable)

The fee committee has yet not approved final fee structure for academic year 2008-09.

Further, it may be noted that the fee structure for the session 2008-2009 will be finalized shortly by the State Level Fee Committee. The candidates are required to pay the fee as prescribed by the committee.

16. EVALUATION AND DECLARATION OF RESULT

- 16.1. For Engineering Courses:** Merit will be prepared on the basis of total marks obtained by the candidate in RPET-2008.
- 16.2.** Cut off Percentage in each course will be decided by Chairperson, CACC before declaration of result. However, percentage of passing in each course for SC & ST candidates will be 5% less than that for other categories. If even after these SC/ST vacancies exist, the vacancies of SC category can be filled by ST candidates and vice versa.
- 16.3.** The merit of a candidate in RPET-2008 will be conveyed through news paper, website and notice board of RPET.
- 16.4.** The marks sheet shall be despatched by post, soon after the publication of RPET merit list. In case a candidate does not receive the marks sheet within two weeks of publication of merit list, for any reason whatsoever, he/she should write to the Coordinator RPET 2008 for another copy which shall be issued on payment of Rs. 50/- by Bank Draft in favour of the Coordinator RPET-2008 payable at Kota.
- 16.5.** In case of equal total marks, the Merit will be decided as under:
- The merit of the candidates of **Engineering** Course securing equal marks in aggregate in the RPET-2008 will be decided on the basis of marks obtained in Mathematics, Physics & chemistry (In that order) at RPET-2008.
 - In case there is a tie on the basis of the above criteria in Engineering course, the relative merit will be decided by the age of the candidate. The candidate of higher age (older candidate) will be placed on higher merit.

17. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

It is proposed the admission will be conducted online by National Informatics Centre (NIC). Further details will be made available on the website in due course of time. In case for any reasons admission is not done by online counselling option form will be supplied during examination for counselling, on 22nd May 2008.

उक्त सीटों पर निम्नानुसार वरीयता दी जावेगी -

1. Category of defence persons for priority will be as follows:-
 - (a) Killed in action
 - (b) Disabled in action and boarded out from service/Died while in service with death attributable to mil service/disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to mil service
 - (c) Gallantry Award Winners
Ex servicemen
2. The domicile requirement for the wards of the Defense personnel from the State of Rajasthan but serving in other State is waived off. For wards of defense personel from other States but serving in the State of Rajasthan, the domicile condition is waived off to enable them to appear in the entrance test and be selected in general quota. However, they would not be eligible for the above mentioned concessions.
3. 50% of the reserved seats will be earmarked for the girls. In the case of non-utilization by girls, the unutilized vacancies would revert back to the boys category.
