## **CIRCULAR**

Government of India (GOI) has established a digital depository of academic awards to be known as National Academic Depository (NAD). To activate this mission, GOI has given the responsibility to University Grants Commission (UGC). UGC has issued a circular **no. D.O. No.F.1.1/2016 (NAD) dated 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2017**, the National Academic Depository (NAD) would be an online store house of academic awards (degrees diplomas, certificates, mark-sheets etc.) lodged by the academic institutions/ boards/eligibility assessment bodies in a digital format. It will be on 24x7 online mode for making available academic awards and shall help in validating their authenticity.

NAD will develop an online portfolio of all education certificates which can be submitted easily for employment, higher education and loan and are easily trusted and verified.

To facilitate the above project, it is mandatory to register all students at NAD. Students are identified primarily using AADHAAR so that the identity of the student is well established and can be electronically verified using e-KYC service framework of UIDAI.

The University has modified examination forms in which AADHAAR number of students shall be filed by the college at the time of filling up of online examination forms.

It shall be the responsibility of college/institution to inform all concerned students that the AADHAAR number of students are mandatory. It shall necessarily to filled correct AADHAAR number by the college at the time of filling up online examination forms. In case of any lapse on the part of college/institution, the concerned college/institution shall be responsible for the same.

The Hon'ble President of India has launched National Academic Depository (NAD) in National Convention on Digital Initiatives for Higher Education held on 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.

National Academic Depository (NAD) is an online store house of academic awards (degrees, diplomas, certificates, mark-sheets etc.) lodged by the academic institutions/boards/eligibility assessment bodies in a digital format. It is a 24x7 online mode for making available academic awards and shall help in validating their authenticity, their safe storage and easy retrieval. NAD is comprising two interoperable digital depositories namely NSDL Database Management Limited (NDML) and CDSL Ventures Limited (CVL). These digital depositories shall keep the academic awards in the digital format and ensure data integrity.

The Government of India has designated University Grants Commission (UGC) as an authorised body for implementation of NAD Project. UGC vide its letter of even no. dated 24<sup>th</sup> November,2016 requested to all the Central Universities, Institutions of National Importance, State Universities, State funded Deemed to be Universities and IIMs to enter into a Service Level Agreement (SLA) with either of the depositories for on-boarding on NAD. UGC had also advised Higher Educational Institutions to designate Nodal Officers and set up NAD cell for implementation of NAD.

You are again requested to establish NAD cell and enter into a Service Level Agreement (SLA) with either of the depositories as early as possible. The template of SLA which is approved by National Steering Committee on NAD is available on NAD website i.e <u>nad.gov.in</u> for your ready reference.
