

At the outset, Mr. Naresh Kumar Malav, Registrar and member secretary welcomed the members of the Academic Council. The meeting started after the hon'ble Chairman along with other members

AC 33.1(S) To consider and approve the recommendations of special meeting of Examination Committee to decide modus operandi on direction issued by State Government vide its letter no. P.1(31)T.E./2008 Part-1 Jaipur, Dated 05.07.2021 with regard to conduction of Final Semester Examinations in online/offline mode and promotion of all rest semesters examinees of session 2020-21.

Explanatory Note:

State Government vide its letter no. P.1(31)T.E./2008 Part-1 Jaipur, dated 05.07.2021 communicated general directions regarding conduction of University Examinations of session 2020-21. Government has directed the University to conduct final semester examinations on online/offline mode and promote rest of the all semester examinees (odd & even) of session 2020-21 (Annexure 33.1.1(s) Page No.1-2)


Matter was placed before Examination Committee to deliberate and decide the modus-operandi on State Government letter. Minutes of Examination Committee are placed before Hon'ble members for consideration and deliberation. (Annexure 33.1.2(s) Page No. 3-7)

A technical cum administrative committee was also constituted to decide and recommend the process of online examinations. Committee recommends to conduct final semester exams on online mode, so as to ensure early conduct and declaration of results. Minutes of the committee are placed before Hon'ble members. (Annexure 33.1.3(s) Page No. 8-12)

Matter is placed before Hon'ble members of the Council for taking decision in the matter.

Resolution: Agenda was approved with following observations.

- Examination of final semesters of session 2020-21 shall be conducted in online remote proctored MCQ mode, as proposed by EC.
- All eligible examinees of intermediate odd and even semesters of session 2020-21, for which examinations could




not be held yet, be promoted without conducting end-term and external practical examinations. This decision will not be applicable on the results of those examinees whose examinations have already been conducted.

- For promotion of B. Tech I Semester, 40% weightage will be taken that of qualifying subjects of qualifying examination such as PCM or as applicable.
- For promotion of all eligible back examinees of intermediate odd and even semesters of session 2020-21, for which examinations could not be held yet, marks will be decided in the concerned subject(s) on the basis of average of pass theory subjects in same semester or minimum passing marks whichever is higher. For practical subjects, recommendations of the Examination Committee be considered. This decision will not be applicable on the results of those examinees whose examinations have already been conducted.
- Above promotion scheme shall also be applicable for the students eligible for mercy back examination of session 2020-21 for which BOM has recently allowed mercy chance in its 39th meeting held on 26-7-2021 vide resolution No. 39.17, except for final semester mercy back students of all UG and PG courses which may be conducted in online/offline mode as per suitability.

AC 33.1(S) **To consider an additional mercy chance to the students of B. Tech, B. Arch., BHMCT, BBA, MCA, MBA, M. Tech. and M. Arch. who have not completed their degree even after completion of double the duration of prescribed course time/permitted course duration.**

Explanatory Note:

1. As per University rules, a student admitted in B. Tech, BHMCT, B. Arch., BBA, MCA, MBA, M. Tech. & M. Arch. course is required to complete his/her course/degree in 8, 8, 10, 6, 6, 4, 4 & 4 years duration respectively i.e. double the duration prescribed for the course.





2. Now, applications/representations are receiving from candidates for granting a mercy chance for the admitted batches of B. Tech. 2013 (LEEP-2014), BHMCT 2013, B. Arch. 2011, BBA 2015, MCA 2015, MBA 2017, M. Tech. 2017 & M. Arch. 2017, who have not completed their degree even after completion of permitted course duration.
3. Previously, as per decision of Academic council and BOM, the students of B. Tech. 2006 to 2012 (LEEP 2007 to 2011), BHMCT 2006 to 2012, BBA 2013 to 2014, MCA 2006 to 2014, MBA 2006 to 2016, M. Tech. & M. Arch. 2006 to 2016 admitted batches were given mercy chance and additional mercy chances who could not pass all papers and not completed their degree within the stipulated period. (Orders are enclosed) (Annexure 33.2(s) Page No. 13-17)

Members are requested to kindly consider the agenda and decide the matter of granting of a mercy chance to students of B. Tech. 2013 (LEEP-2014), BHMCT 2013, B. Arch. 2011, BBA 2015, MCA 2015, MBA 2017, M. Tech. 2017 & M. Arch. 2017 admitted batches in the academic session 2021-22 along with the other regular batches.

Members are requested to approve the same.
